Discontinued

Food items that are longer available through the shop:

- Traidcraft Blueberry Dusted Raisins-discontinued by Traidcraft.
- Maya Gold Chocolate-discontinued due to poor sales and customer concern about Cadbury takeover.
- Green and Blacks cocoa-discontinued, same reasons as Maya Gold
- Suma Dried Aduki and Dried Black Beans-discontinued due to very poor sales over an extended period, however, aduki beans and black beans are still available in tinned form.

Out of Stock

Food items currently out of stock in the shop:

- Eswatini Lime Marmalade
- Eswatini Pure Orange Marmalade
- Eswatini Swazi Fire Sauce-all due to waiting for Coach House to be restocked.
- Buchanan's Toffees
- Buchanan's Butterscotch
- Palestinian Dates
- Small bottles Palestinian Olive Oil
- Traidcraft cocoa and hot chocolate-Traidcraft having problems with packing.
- Apple Juice-still trouble sourcing fair trade apples.
- Cotton wool pads-discontinued by Traidcraft, currently we are trying to find a new supplier.

New(ish)

Household items in the shop:

- **Rubber Gloves** - blue, size medium, made in Sri Lanka with fair trade rubber latex.

Food items in the shop:

- **Traidcraft Chocolate box** - it's red filled with lovely chocs such as "sticky toffee dome" "plain chocolate and orange liquor leaves". Selling for £4.00.
- **Seed and Bean Co. chocolate bars** -72% cocoa with mandarin and ginger or rose, retailing at £1.70 they are organic and suitable for vegans.
- **Kilombero rice.**

An aromatic long grain rice virtually unknown in the UK which is an excellent accompaniment to stews & curries and is ideal for risottos and paellas.

From Malawi, the rice is grown as a cash crop to supplement usual crops (like cassava) grown for subsistence. The income from rice crops enables farmers to improve their buildings, buy fertilizer and tools, have access to transport and education for children.

Every 90kgs of rice a farmer can sell at a fair price provides sufficient income for that farmer to send one child to High School. A great achievement as only 1 in 3 children in Malawi attend High School.

Kilombero rice is available in 1kg bags priced at £3.50 in the shop. I'd like to add that it is yummy just on it's own when you follow the instructions on the packet!
